

The connection between low pay, debt and mental health

- Low earners are three and a half times more likely than the high earners to have debt worth more than six months of their income
- People with unmanageable debt are 24 per cent more likely to experience poor mental health
- One in four believed low pay negatively affected their relationship with their family and friends
- 71% worry so much it affects their day to day life
- 35% always, or quite often, feel lonely
- Almost a quarter believe low pay has negatively affected their relationship with their children (23.9%)
- 32% feel their pay negatively affects the quality of their relationship with their partner
