London Wall West (150 London Wall – the current home of the Museum of London – and Bastion House) is seeking public input on the future of the site:

'We will shortly be launching the next phase of consultation, offering a chance to view and comment on our early vision as we continue to develop plans for the site. We will be hosting two public consultation events at Level 2, Barbican Centre, EC2Y 8DS, where you can see the proposals and speak to members of the project team.
