Public Health Updates

NEW UPDATE ON COVID 19 VACCINES FOR THE OVER 80'S

Guidance has now changed, if you know of a resident who is over the age of 80 and has not been contacted about attending a Covid-19 vaccine appointment, please ask them to contact their GP and they will be able to help.

For all other age or priority groups - please continue to wait for the NHS to contact you

UNPAID CARERS ARE A PRIORITY FOR THE VACCINE

Unpaid carers are people of any age who look after a friend or relative who needs support because of a physical or learning disability, mental illness or impaired health due to sickness or old age.

Unpaid carers are in a priority group for the COVID-19 vaccine. It's really important that unpaid carers are registered with their GPs as a carer, so that they can receive the vaccine once they're eligible.

The NHS have not given a timescale about when the vaccination will be given to carers, but we know that you **must wait** to hear from the NHS. Unlike normal flu vaccinations, carers **will not** be offered their vaccination at the same time as the person they care for at this time. However, the advice is that the vaccine will be offered more widely, as soon as possible.
