

The Health and Social Care services you can access over the Christmas Period

Over the Christmas Period, many Health and Social Care services will close or have reduced opening hours. We have compiled the following list of information for you.

NHS 111

If you have an urgent, but not life-threatening health problem you can contact NHS 111. Simply dial 111, the call is free from landline and mobiles. You answer questions about your symptoms on telephone by speaking to a fully trained adviser on the phone. You can ask for a translator if you need one.

Depending on the situation you will:

- Find out what local service can help you
- Be connected to a nurse, emergency dentist, pharmacist or GP
- Get a face-to-face appointment if you need one
- Be told how to get any medicine you need
- Get self-care advice

In an emergency you should always dial 999

COMMUNITY NURSES

 If you need to access to the community nurses service, first call your GP practice, if they are closed call NHS 111

DENTAL EMERGENCIES

• If you need to access emergency dental services, call NHS 111, a dental nurse will assess you over the phone and can offer you an appointment if needed

If you need to access an emergency pharmacy, you can access support through the Homerton Hospital.


The service is available Monday, Wednesday and Friday, 9am to 5pm.
