Who is eligible?

City and Hackney registered patients/residents deemed as vulnerable: Over 55, living alone or a carer – at risk of mobility issues or falls.

Exclusions:

No serious foot pathology management eg vascular, neurological or surgical issues. If in doubt about a patient/client the referrer should seek advice from the Homerton Foot Health service Tel: 020 7684 4046/4347
